



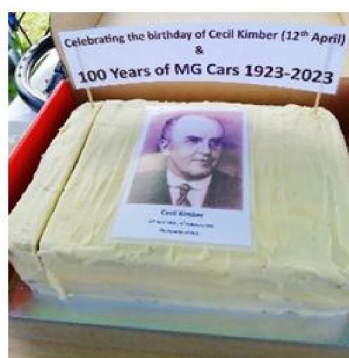
## April 16th Run to the Rongotea Car Show & Swap Meet
