VISITS: Include; Upper Norsewood Museum (\$2.00 each entry), Jail, Scandinavian History, and café lunch. After lunch travel to Lower Norsewood and visit the Norse Wear Factory Shop (NZ Natural Clothing), Hovding Gallery, and the 'Wop Wops' wetlands where eels the size of MG's can be seen – don't worry the eels will eat the MG's and spit out the owners.

Eel food can be purchased at the NZ Natural Clothing Shop.

LUNCH: At the excellent Norsewood Café.

DIRECTIONS: Travel over The Te Ahu a Turanga/Manawatu – Tararua Highway to Woodville.

Turn right at Woodville onto SH 2 towards Pahiatua. Take first left into Pollen Street and park up along side Fountaine Reserve for our morning tea stop. Toilets are available for those in need.

After morning tea we travel on SH 2 towards Dannevirke, continue though Dannevirke, to turn left into Upper Norsewood. Park up and begin your tour of the village in your own time before lunch. The time for lunch will be advised upon arrival in Norsewood.
